Chicago Women in Trades and our partners are committed to ensuring access and participation for aspiring tradeswomen to attend the **2017 Women Build Nations** conference as it is critical to their success and ours to have a strong community and active participation in the tradeswomen movement. To that end, we have a limited number of scholarships through the *Aspiring Tradeswomen Scholarship Fund* for women who are pre-apprenticeship training program participants or recent graduates of a program and not yet in an apprenticeship program or employed fulltime in a blue collar career.

Scholarship funds are very limited and are only eligible for the cost of conference registration. *Scholarships are provided on a first come, first served basis.* Applications must be received by **September 15th 2017** for consideration. All applications will be verified of pre-apprenticeship training program status with the training program provider. Travel, lodging, and other conference event fees are not included.
