

## OFFICIAL INFORMATION REGARDING APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITIES

I.B.E.W. Local 134 and the Electrical Contractors Association through the Electrical Joint Apprenticeship Trust will open registration for the Communications Apprenticeship Program.

**Online Registration** 

Begins at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 5, 2018.

The first five hundred (500) time stamped completed registrations will be taken and after that number is satisfied, no additional registrations will be taken.

- 1. Beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 5, 2018, interested candidates will go to <a href="www.ejatt.com">www.ejatt.com</a>, click on Programs and go to the Communications Registration tab.
- 2. Enter the information required and upload a valid Driver's License, a Social Security Card, and a U.S. Birth Certificate, U.S. Passport, Permanent Resident Alien Card, or other proof of authorization to work in the U.S.A. (minimum age of 17 at registration). The upload can be done from a photo taken on a cell phone. Instructions will be provided on the website on how to perform these tasks. All completed registrations will be time stamped and acknowledged by email subject to confirmation.
- 3. An email will be sent confirming the completed registration. Continued eligibility for the program requires the submission of additional information <u>in-person</u> (photo I.D. required) on the dates and times specified in the email:
  - a. A \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee (Only Cash or Money Order payable to EJATT).
  - b. Proof of High School Graduation: a copy of a Diploma, a transcript, or GED Certificate is required. (Final semester HS seniors may register pending graduation).
  - c. Proof of one year of high school level Algebra or higher level course with a minimum of "C": transcript required. Note: The GED Math Certification does not satisfy this requirement.
  - d. Additional optional documentation may be submitted as outlined in the email.

Upon an offer of apprenticeship, you must be able to demonstrate that you can perform the essential functions of an apprentice electrician with or without a reasonable accommodation. In addition, a drug screen, physical exam, and background check will be required. The number of Apprentices admitted to the program is based on the needs of the industry. Selection of Apprentices is based on confirmed registrations in order of time stamp.

EJATT will not discriminate against apprenticeship applicants or apprentices based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), sexual orientation, genetic information, or because they are an individual with a disability or a person 40 years old or older. The EJATT will take affirmative action to provide equal opportunity in apprenticeship and will operate the apprenticeship program as required under Title 29 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 30."
